




dominique coulon blends care & retirement home into the landscape of northern france



dominique coulon has completed a large healthcare facility for dependent elderly people in the northwestern french village of orbec. visible from the valley below, the 115-bed care and retirement home follows the topography of the hillside, and has been designed to be as unobtrusive as possible. to reduce the imposing structure's visual impact, the design team divided it into smaller volumes that fan out across the landscape.

dominique coulon & associés sought to further disguise the mass through an effective use of color. 'we achieved the desired effect by using the colour green, with the result that the building both blends into the larger landscape and reflects the rural nature of the site,' explain the architects. 'the under-faces of the overhangs and the white walls of the base produce a feeling of lightness.'

to reduce the imposing structure's visual impact, the design team divided it into smaller volumes

each living unit fits into one section of the building, and all remain connected to a south-facing street, backed by the hill. this layout offers views through the structure from one side to the other, with light punctuating primary circulation routes. the color red has been used to 'destructure' the interiors, creating bold and dynamic spaces atypical to the conventional colors normally used in healthcare environments.






